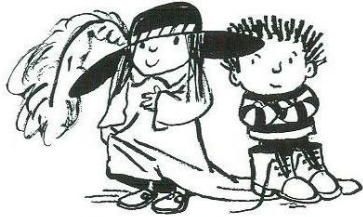

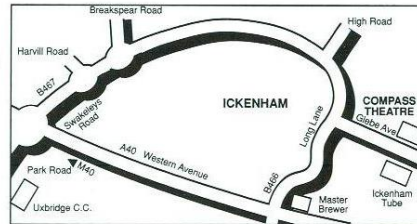

if you require an adapted space in the auditorium.

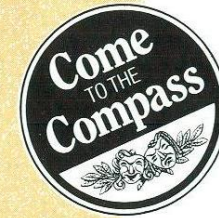
## HOW TO FIND US

- **BY ROAD**  
We are close  
to the centre of  
Ickenham.  
Take the A40  
and turn off  
onto the  
B466/A434.  
Turn towards  
Ruislip and  
Ickenham.  
Glebe Avenue  
is on the right. Pass the Underground station in  
Glebe Avenue and the Compass is immediately on  
the left.
- **BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT**  
We are opposite the Ickenham Underground  
Station which is served by the Metropolitan and  
Piccadilly lines. The U1 bus runs from Uxbridge  
to Ickenham.
