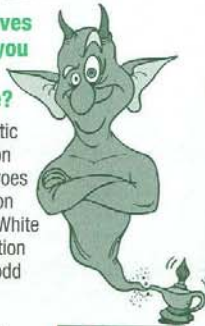
## LOST IN PANTOLAND WORKSHOP

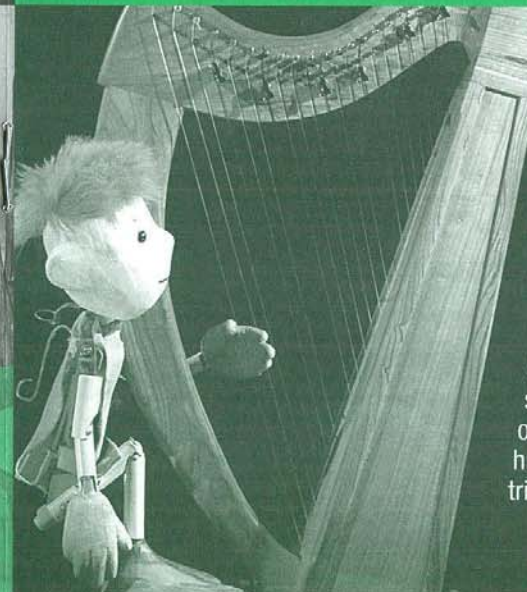

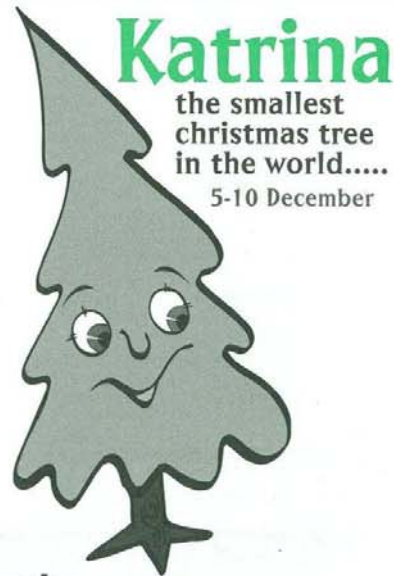
