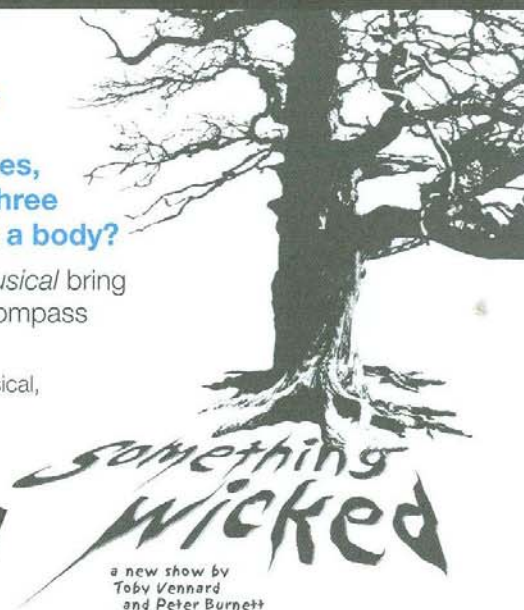
What do you get if you take an old English Village surrounded by ancient stones, add an evil gnarled tree, a three hundred year old curse and a body?

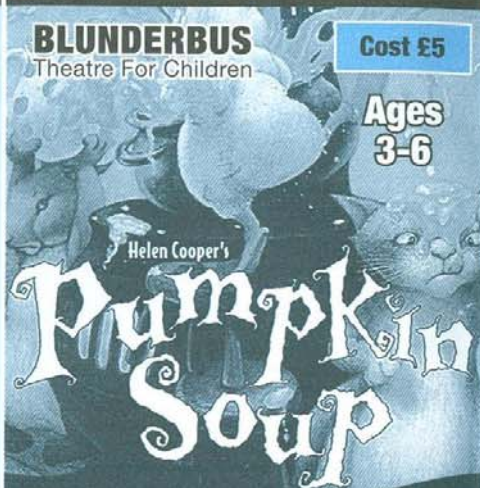

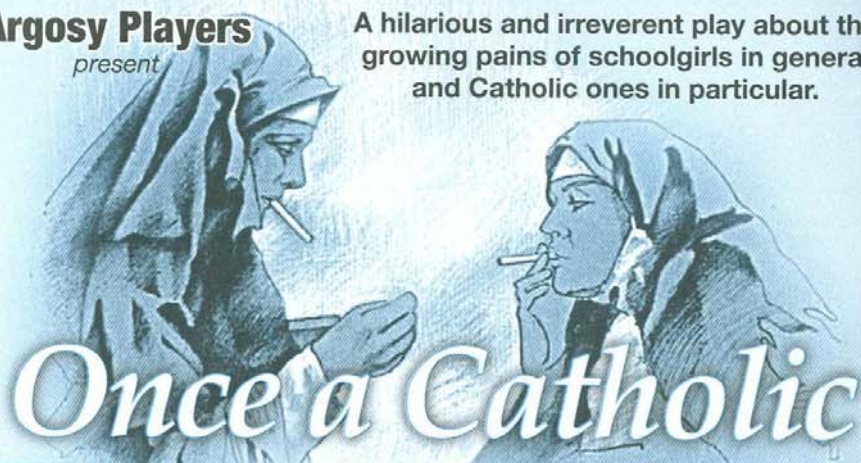

Bistro & bar

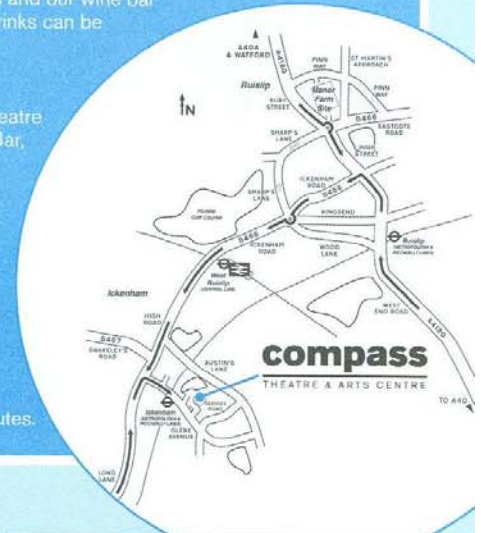
Our coffee bar is open for all performances and our wine bar opens on all performance nights. Interval drinks can be ordered from the wine bar.
