Ticket Exchanges and Resales

We regret ticket money cannot be refunded unless a performance is cancelled. If you are unable to attend a performance for which you have booked tickets, the Box Office will try and re-sell your returned tickets although we can only do this once a performance has sold out. In exceptional circumstances we may be able to transfer tickets within a run. For either re-sale or exchange, a £1.50 administration fee per booking will apply.
