Bookings

Ticket bookings can be made in person, by post or by telephone. Box Office is open from 10.30am-5pm, Monday - Friday and from 10am-1pm on Saturdays. If paying by cheque, please make payable to 'Compass Theatre'. Tickets can be reserved for 5

Ticket Exchanges and Resales

We regret ticket money cannot be refunded unless a performance is cancelled. If you are unable to attend a performance for which you have booked tickets, the Box Office will try and re-sell your returned tickets although we can only do this once a performance has sold out. In exceptional circumstances we may be able to transfer ckets within a run. For either re-sale or exchange, a £1.50 administration fee per booking will apply.

How to find us

The Compass Theatre is on Ickenham's Glebe Avenue, just 150 yards from Long Lane. Ickenham Underground Station is just across the road (Metropolitan & Piccadilly Lines). West Ruislip Station is a 15 minute walk away (Central Line & British Rail). ckenham is served by the U1& U10 bus routes.

Children

We welcome children, and have an extensive programme of performances, workshops and other activities dedicated to the under 12's. Please note that in the interests of other patrons, babes in arms and children under the age of 3 years are not permitted in the Auditorium (including children's performances). Children under the age of 8 years must be accompanied by an adult.
