Advance Booking

Tickets are available (unless otherwise stated) from the Hillingdon Arts Service Box Office based at Compass Theatre which is open Mon-Fri 10.30am to 5pm and Sat 10am to 1pm. Reservations can be made online at www.compasstheatre.co.uk.

The Box Office generally opens 45 minutes before a show for ticket collections and unreserved door sales. Reservations are not held for payment on the door so patrons are advised to book in advance using debit / credit cards, cash or cheques made payable to *London Borough of Hillingdon*. A booking fee of £1.75 is applied to non-cash bookings, which helps to improve the theatre.

Events with few or no advance sales may be cancelled. Tickets are non-refundable unless an event is cancelled. We make every effort to ensure that all details are correct but reserve the right to make changes or alterations as necessary.

Access

Compass Theatre can be accessed by wheelchair and has 2 spaces for wheelchairs in the auditorium, 3 parking bays for disabled badge holders and accessible toilet facilities. Wheelchair assistants come free and assistance dogs are welcome. The auditorium and box office are fitted with induction loops. Baby changing facilities are available. Babies under 18 months may be admitted to appropriate events with a lap ticket, issued at the box office.

Photography, Video Recording and Mobile Phones

The use of cameras and recording apparatus is not permitted in the Auditorium and mobile phones must be switched off.

Refreshments

The Café and Wine bars are generally open 45 minutes before a show and during intervals and are staffed by volunteers.

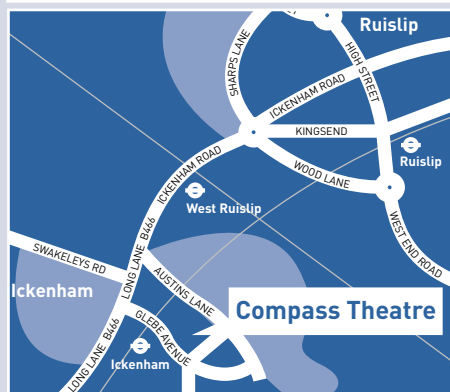
By Bus: Ickenham is served by the U1 and U10 bus routes.

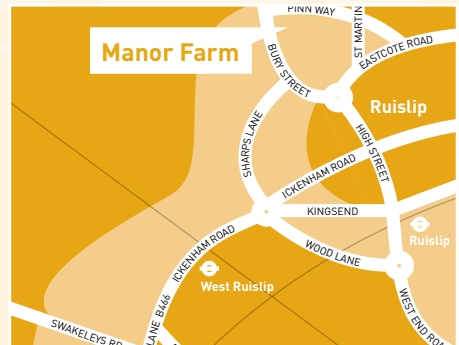
