Theatre Volunteer Role Profile: **WARDROBE**

Open to those aged 16+

Compass Theatre's first floor has a volunteer-run costume hire service, with 5 rooms packed full of theatrical wardrobe items. The wardrobe is located up the spiral staircase leading from the foyer. There is no lift to the wardrobe, so this volunteer role is not suitable for those unable to climb the spiral staircase.

The Wardrobe offers hour-long, pre-booked appointments to costume hirers on Wednesdays at 5.30pm and 6.30pms and Saturdays at 11am and 12pm.

Wardrobe volunteers do not need to have any prior costume knowledge or experience, nor will they be asked to make costumes or adjust costumes to fit. They are only needed to help costume hirers find the items they need, and to put away costumes returned from hire. Payment for costume hire is taken via the box office, and a Box Office Volunteer is assigned to every appointment to book the chosen costumes out, and book them back again, on return.

New volunteers train by attending sessions with more experienced volunteers and get to know where different costumes are kept by putting away costumes returned from hire.

Once trained, Wardrobe Volunteers are required to come in for at least two sessions per month, and choose the shifts they want, from a list of those available, sent out weekly by email.

Hillingdon Theatres' Volunteers act as ambassadors for the borough's community theatres and the productions they house and, such may request two free tickets for most shows, subject to availability. Shows not included in that offer are those raising funds for either the Friends of Ickenham Hall or the Mayor of Hillingdon's chosen charities.
