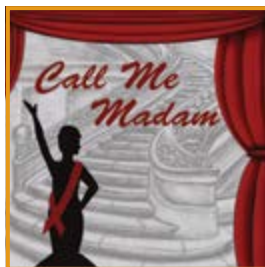
## Call Me Madam

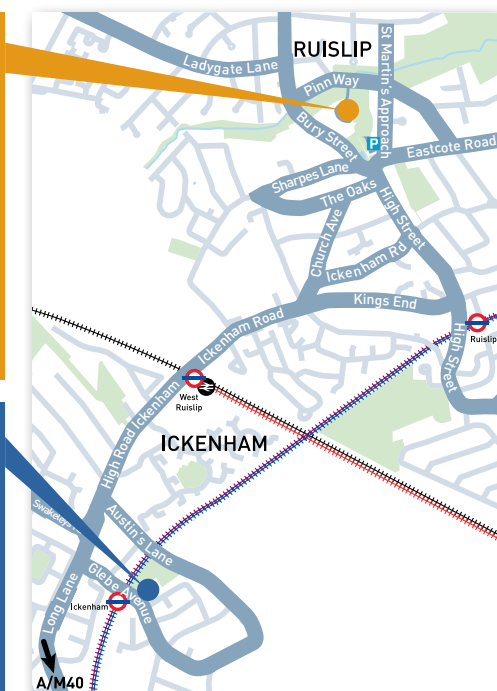
